

**FREE WILL OFFERING BAKE SALE: ATTENTION SCHOOL FAMILIES:** During the benefit fish fry for Derrick DeWilde, there will also be a free will offering bake sale. We are asking for baked goods to be donated from school families. Please make sure your baked good is "bake sale ready," meaning, already on plates and wrapped, or in bags ready to serve. Bake sale items do not need to be marked with a price. Items may be brought to the school office Thursday, October 12 or Friday, October 13. Thank you for your support!

**FLU CLINIC:** The Randolph County Health Department (RCHD) will partner with the Retired and Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) in Randolph County to provide flu clinics. We will host one at our school on Wednesday, October 18 from 2-5 in the school lobby. The RSVP sponsored by Western Egyptian EOC will assist the RCHD with volunteers. **Everyone 6 months of age and older needs to receive flu vaccine every year** and is welcome to get their flu vaccine at any of these clinics. High dose flu vaccine for those 65 years and older as well as Pediatric flu vaccine for those 6-35 months is available. Regular and Pediatric flu vaccine are \$35 per dose. High dose flu vaccine is \$65 per dose. The flu mist is not available this year. We are able to bill the following: 1) Medicare 2) Medicaid (for individuals age 19 and older) with a valid card 3) Current or retired state of Illinois employees. Individuals not covered by the above can pay by cash or check. A receipt and, if needed, information to submit an insurance claim, will be provided. Children age 18 and younger, covered by Medicaid, will need to call the RCHD to schedule an appointment.

**FALL PICTURE DAY:** Fall pictures are scheduled for Oct. 19<sup>th</sup> and retake day is Nov. 20<sup>th</sup>. 4 year old preschool will get their pictures on retake day since they are not in class on Oct. 19<sup>th</sup>, however if you would like them to get them on the 19<sup>th</sup> you are more than welcome to bring them in at **8:15**. Just come to main lobby since that is where Lifetouch will be set up. Picture packets will be sent home soon.

2. All items must be suitable for family viewing.
3. All items must be non-edible. No ready to eat food will be sold for profit during the fair.
4. Each exhibitor will provide his/her own materials to exhibit their crafts (e.g. table, chairs, signs, etc ...). Tables and chairs will be available for rental for \$4.00 and \$3.00/\$2.00 respectively.
5. No help will be provided for exhibitors in setting up or taking down their booth space.
6. The school will be open at 7:00 am for vendor set-up. Exhibitors must be on the school grounds by 10AM or we reserve the right to reassign your booth space(s).
7. Vendors will not be automatically assigned the same spaces from previous years. Special requests will be honored to the best of our ability.
