CAMP INVENTION: SPPCS will be hosting Camp Invention, a nationally recognized STEM based camp focusing on engineering and design, problem-solving and teamwork. This will be the 11th year that SPPCS has hosted Camp Invention. Camp Invention's curriculum aligns with state standards and is taught by certified teachers. The date for our camp is the week of June 11-15, 2018. Camp Invention is open to all students entering first through sixth grade. ****Families will need to submit an application to an SGO. (Proof of income and residency)(Birth certificate for Kindergarten or first grade)**

****Families are notified of their status.**

****Students begin enrollment process with the school.**

****Scholarship notifications are sent in February and will continue until funds are used.**

****Funds will be distributed to schools at the start of the 2018-2019 school year on a quarterly basis.**

****If a student decides to transfer schools mid-year, the scholarships will follow the students to a new school.**

PARENTS WHO PAY TUITION: Any family wishing to apply for Scholarship money through the Lutheran Elementary School Association will use TADS this year. The online application process through TADS Tuition Aid & Assessment service (mytads.com/fa/lesa) is open to our families, and April 1, 2018 is the deadline for applications that will be considered during the (initial) May awards process. Applications made after the April 1 date will be considered in the June awards process. More information is available in the office.

SCHOOL SECURITY: The tragic school shootings remind us of the importance of security in our own school building. The only public entrances during the school day are from the south parking lot through door #1 (school) and the west parking lot door #11 (daycare). You have to be buzzed in for access. Guests in the school must register at the receptionist's desk and receive a badge to have access to school. Thank you for abiding by these safety measures.

COACHES NEEDED:
