FLU SHOT CLINIC: The Randolph County Health Department will be hosting a Walk-In Flu Shot Clinic at our school on Thursday, October 18th from 2:30-4:30pm. Everyone, age 6 months and older, can receive flu vaccine. A parent or guardian would need to complete and sign our consent form for those under 18 and we would need a check for the amount of the vaccine. The regular flu vaccine is available for those ages 3 and older. Pediatric vaccine is available for those age 6 months to under 3. The high-dose vaccine is a choice for those ages 65 and older to receive. They accept Medicare and current / retired state of IL employees (prison, Chester Mental Health, etc). Anyone else can receive a flu shot and can pay with cash or a check. We offer a receipt and an insurance form for those that want to submit to their own insurance for reimbursement.

2ND, 7TH & 8TH GRADE FIELD TRIP: The 2nd, 7th and 8th graders will be going on a Field Trip on October 19th. They will be going to see "The Little Mermaid" at the Touhill Performing Arts Center on UMSL's campus. 
