All other BASC students will use the North bus door number 8 for drop off and pick up unless pick up is before 4:00pm, then you may use the main office door. A doorbell has been installed at door 8. This can be used to notify staff that you are here get your children. On no school days OR 11:20 dismissal days, care will NOT be available. There will be NO After School Care on the following days Fri. Jan. 28, Fri. Feb. 18, and Fri. March 25. On Thurs. April 14 Before school care is available but No after school care available due to the start of Easter break.
